5.Leave is sought. Leave is granted.

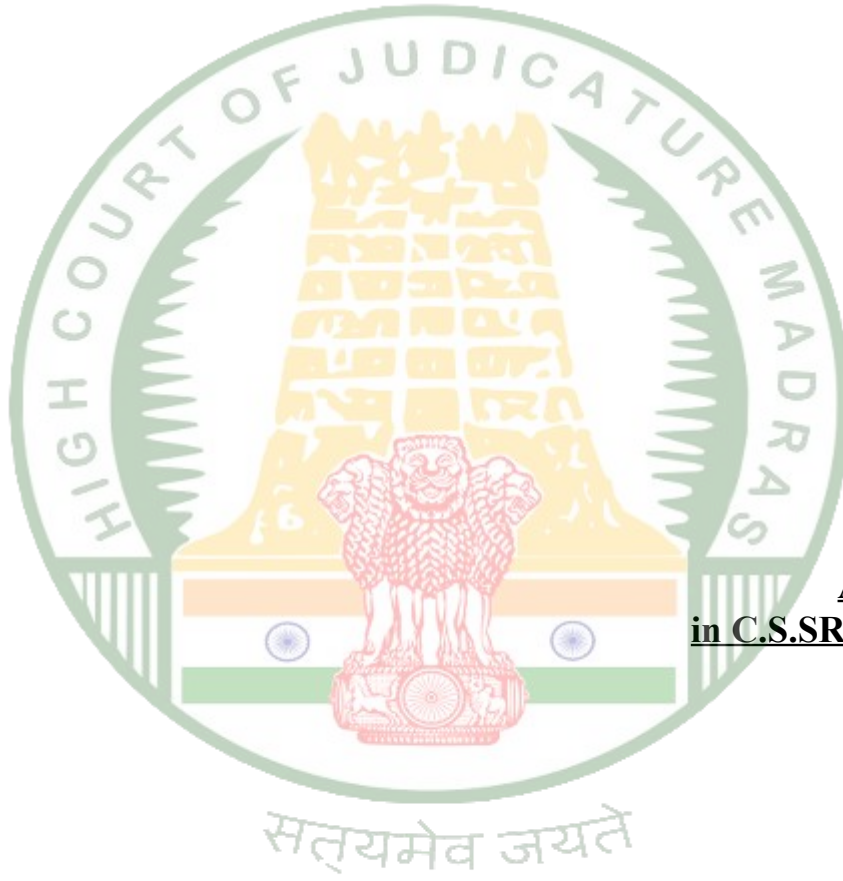
6.Registry may number the plaint if it is in order.
