Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detention order passed against the petitioner's son in C3/D.O.No.105/2019 dated 22.09.2019 on the file of the first respondent is revoked vide G.O.Rt.No.4868, Home, Prohibition and Excise (IX) Department, dated 29.11.2019 and produced a copy of the said order.

In view of the above, this petition is closed as it has become infructuous.
