Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detention order passed against the son of the petitioner in 638/BCDFGISSSV/2019 dated 03.10.2019 on the file of the second respondent is revoked vide G.O.Rt.No.4928, Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 29.11.2019 and produced a copy of the said order.
