4. Instant OP is dismissed as withdrawn preserving the rights of the petitioner in the aforesaid matter. No costs.

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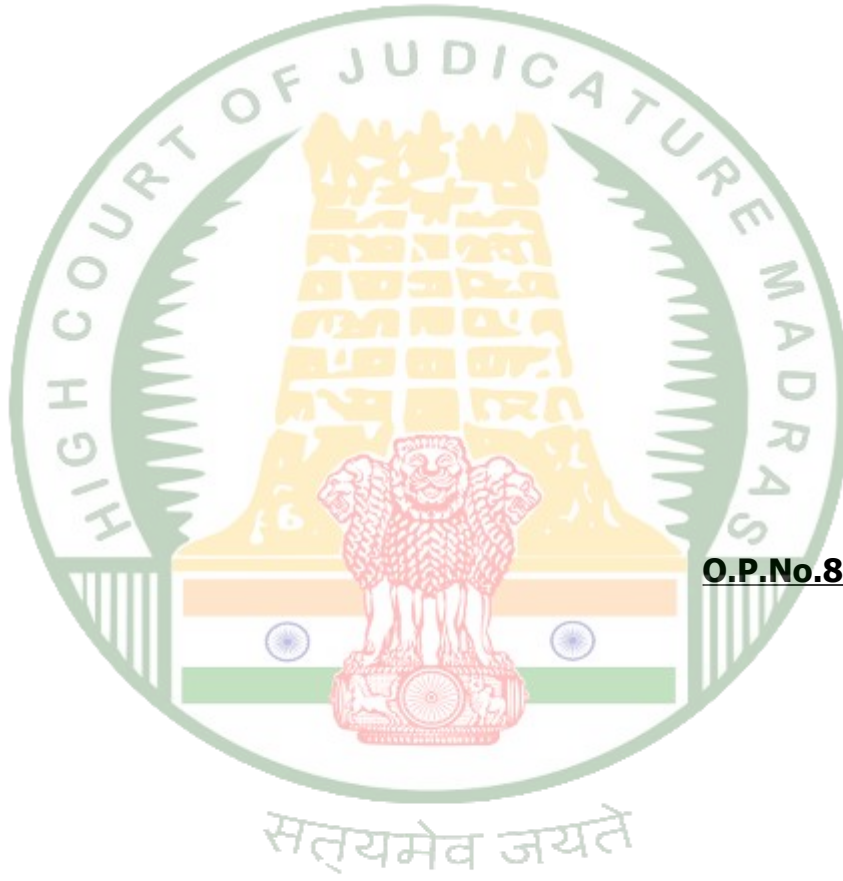
