Petitioner is the wife of the detenu viz., Sikkandar S/o.Rafiq, aged about 25 years, who has been branded as 'Goonda' under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 and detained under orders of second respondent passed in Memo No.C3/D.O.No.114/2019 dated 18.10.2019. Such order is under challenge herein.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detention order passed against the husband of the petitioner in Memo No.C3/D.O.No.114/2019 dated 18.10.2019 on the file of the second respondent is revoked vide G.O.Rt.No.4871, Home, Prohibition and Excise (IX) Department, dated 29.11.2019 and produced a copy of the said order.

In view of the above, this petition is closed as it has become infructuous.
