2.Hence, this Civil Revision Petition is dismissed for default. No costs. Consequently, connected Civil Miscellaneous Petition is also closed.

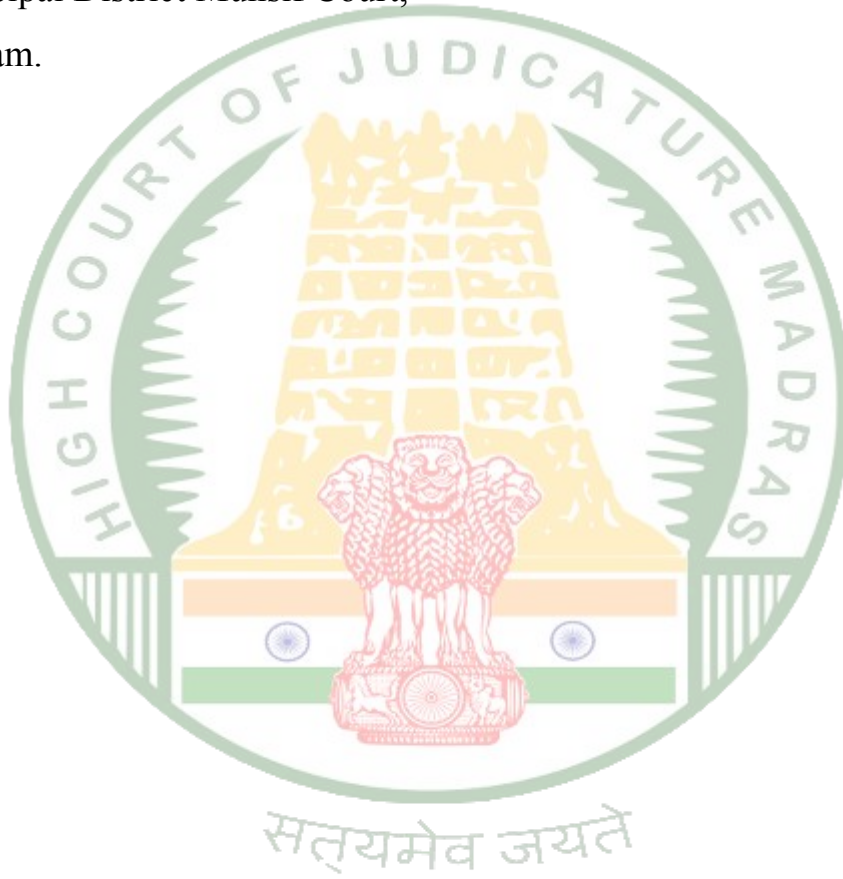

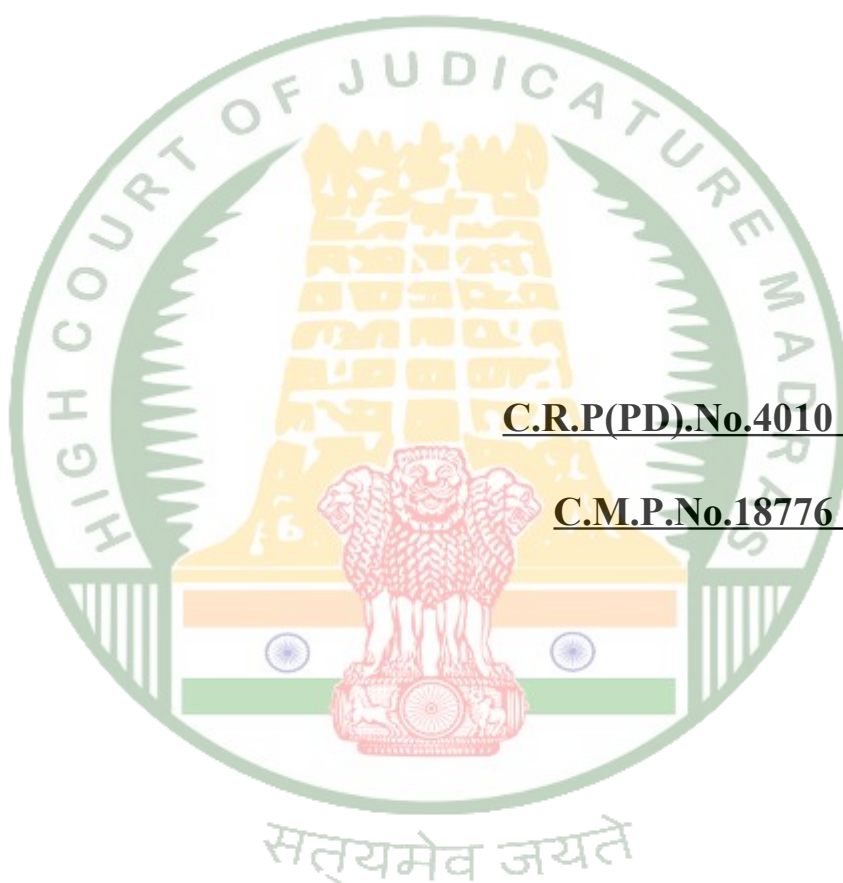


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
