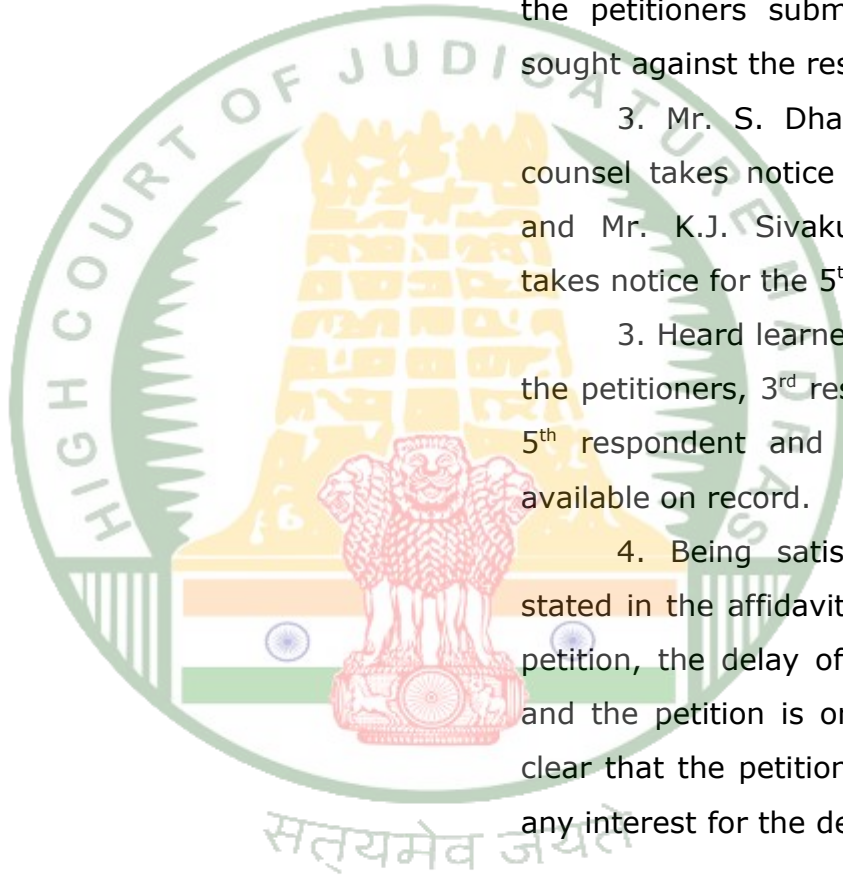
This petition is filed to condone the delay of 702 days in filing the above appeal.
