PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Habeas Corpus, directing to call for the entire records, relating to the petitioner's son detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order dated 05.11.2019 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings memo C3/D.O./94/2019, quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents herein to produce the petitioner's son viz., Thirukumaran S/o. Selvam aged 23 years before this Hon'ble High Court and set the petitioner's son at liberty from detention, now the petitioner's son detained at Central Prison, Cuddalore.
