ORDER

4. I have heard and considered the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for petitioner and perused the records carefully.

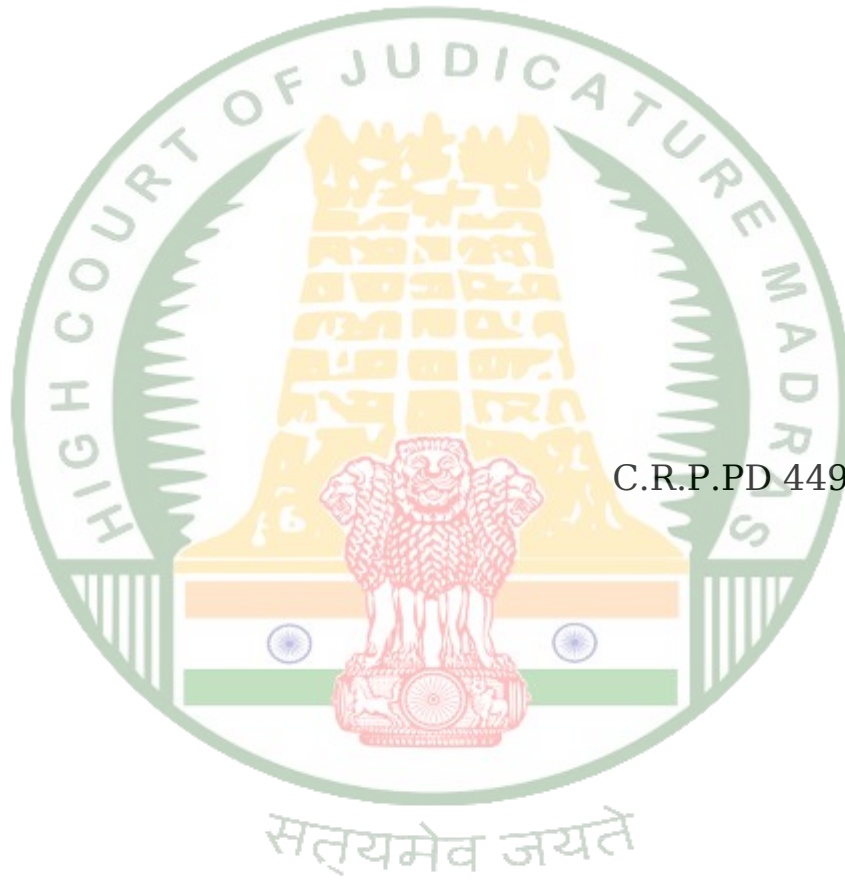
