Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records of the 2nd respondent dated 29.12.2016 vide No.MA.HA-9/VA.THU.NA.KA.No. R1/SIRAPU/2016 culminating in Demand notice bearing Bill No.09-117-10444 -000/08-114-1734-000 and quash the same and consequently direct the second respondent to inspect the schedule mentioned premises and reassess the same as a residential property.

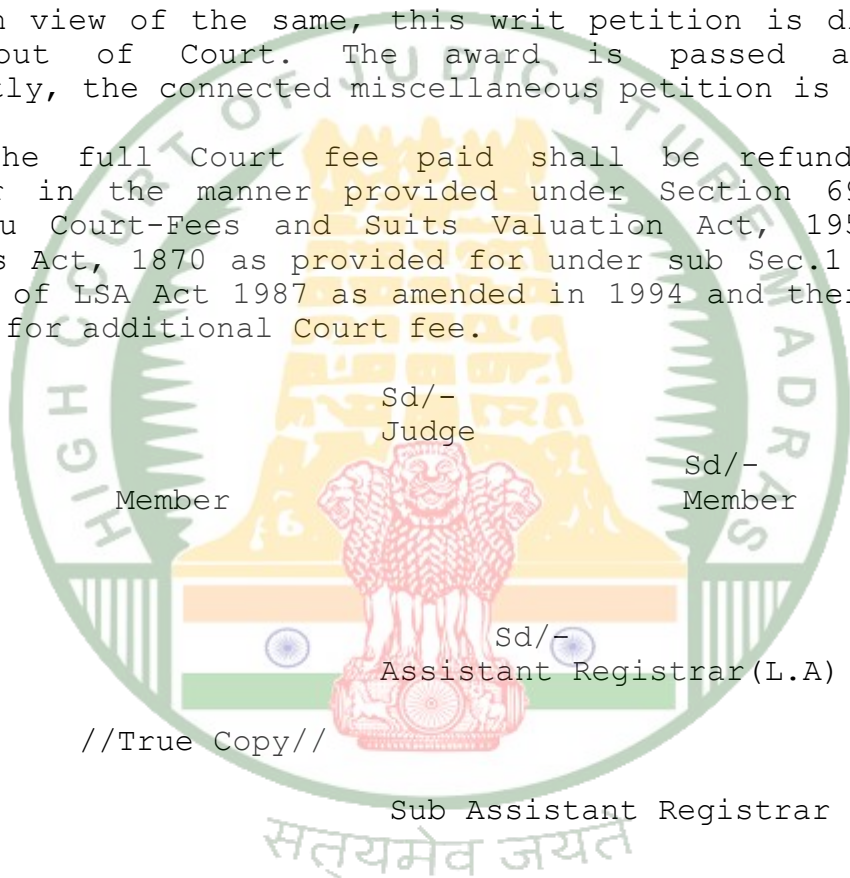

The full Court fee paid shall be refunded to the petitioner in the manner provided under Section 69-A of the Tamil Nadu Court-Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955 and the Court Fees Act, 1870 as provided for under sub Sec.1 of Section 21 r/w 25 of LSA Act 1987 as amended in 1994 and there shall be no demand for additional Court fee.

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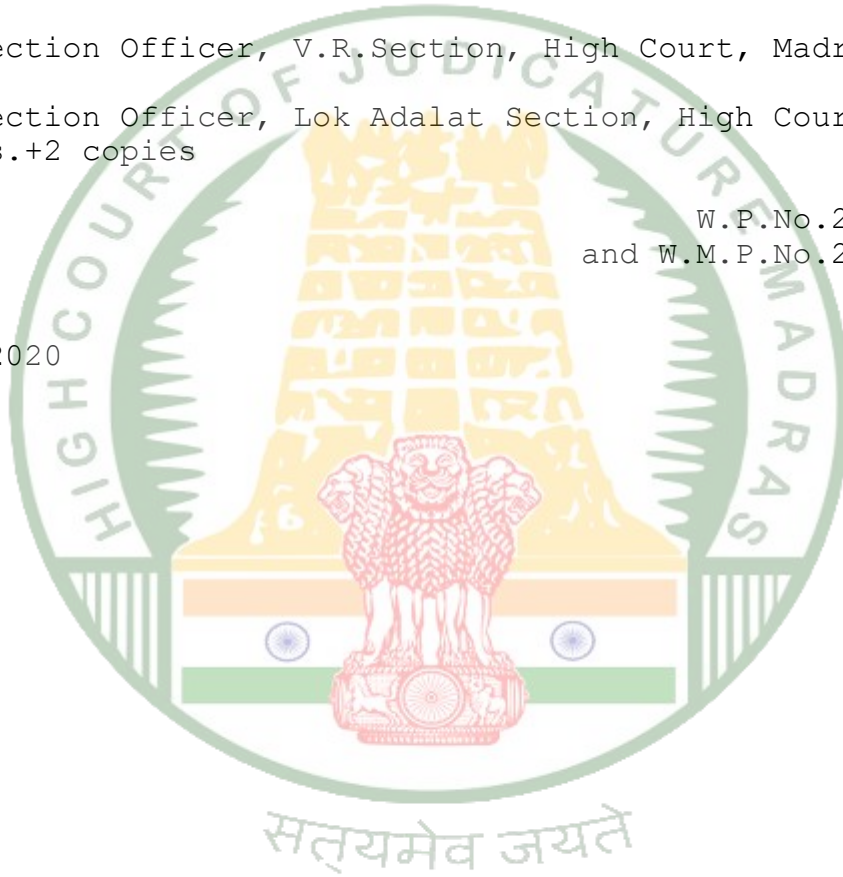
