This Court, by order dated 22.09.2017, granted an order of interim stay on condition to deposit 50% of the award amount with proportionate interest and costs by the appellant / insurance company, within a period of four weeks.

2. Today, when the case is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the appellant insurance company, on instructions, submitted that the conditional order dated 22.09.2017 has been duly complied with by the appellant.

3. In view of the above, interim order already granted is made absolute and this Civil Miscellaneous Petition is ordered accordingly.

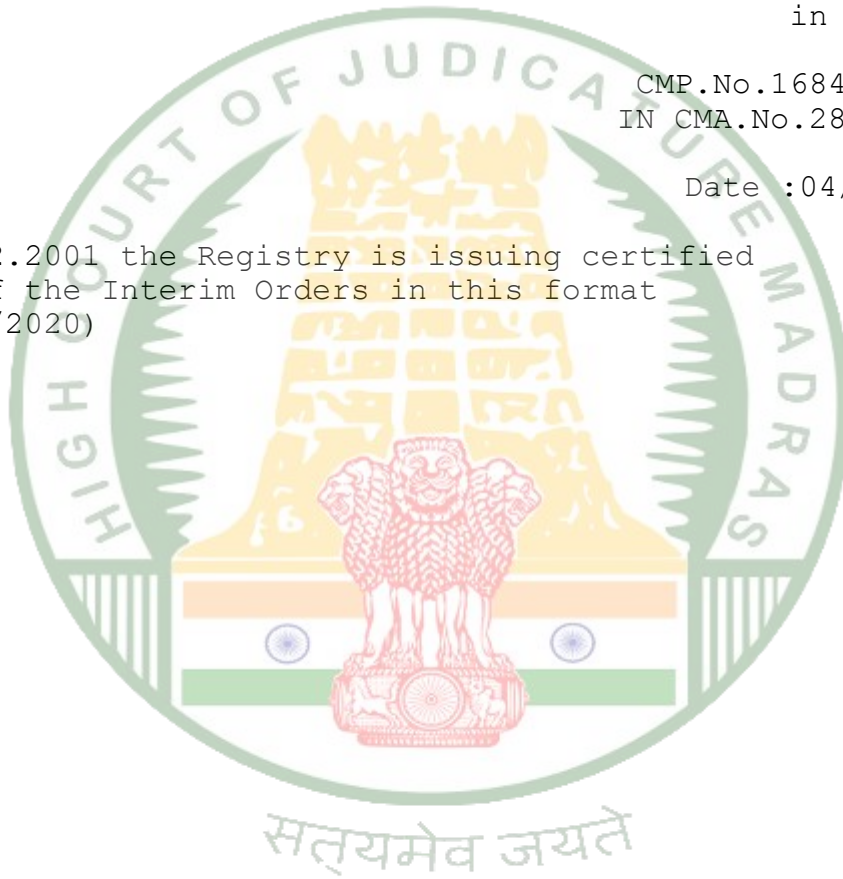
