Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuing a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to adhere the G.O.Ms.No.92, Municipal Administration and Water Supply (MCII) Department dated 03.07.2007 in renewing the lease of Shop No.9 (Allotment No.044/227), East Pandy Road, Villupuram and consequently restraining the respondent from demanding and collecting arbitrarily fixed rent as per the letter Na.Ka.No.14546/2016/A5 dated 04.05.2017 and/or demanding more than 15% of the lease amount fixed for the previous block period.
