2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

3.From the status report filed by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, it appears that despite an endeavour being made, the detainee is yet to be secured.

4.Inasmuch as the detainee is missing from 05.04.2019 onwards and the investigation is still going on, as could be seen from

the status report, this habeas corpus petition stands closed with a direction to the second respondent/Station House Officer, to continue with the investigation and trace the detainee.
