2.The wife of the detenu has challenged the detention order passed against the detenu in Cr.M.P.No.19/Sexual Offender/2019

dated 04.11.2019, branding him as 'Sexual Offender' under Section 2 (ggg) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 by the second respondent for having sexually assaulted the minor girl children aged about 5 and 6 years.

3.It is seen from the records that the period of detention is over as the detention order was passed on 04.11.2019 and the Prayer sought for in the petition has become infructuous.

4.Accordingly, this Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
