This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 245 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2.The first respondent remained exparte before the Tribunal and hence, notice to the first respondent is dispensed with. M/s.I.Malar, learned counsel takes notice for the second respondent and submitted that the second respondent has no objection in ordering this petition.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the second respondent.
