Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of habeas corpus to call for the entire records, relating to petitioner's son detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order, dated 18.11.2019 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings No.787/BCDFGISSSV/2019 and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents herein to produce the said petitioner's son namely, Sethu (a) Sethupathy, son of Selvam, aged 25 years before this Hon'ble High Court and set the petitioner's son at liberty from detention, now petitioner's son detained at Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai - 600 066.

The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in No.787/BCDFGISSSV/2019 dated 18.11.2019 detaining her son as

"Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.106 Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 07.01.2020 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
