Prayer: Criminal Original petition is filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to direct the respondent police not to harass the petitioner.

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the respondent police not to harass the petitioner.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that based on the complaint given by one Purushothaman, the respondent is unnecessarily harassing the petitioner.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has submitted that since one Purushothaman has lodged a complaint against the petitioner and only for enquiry purpose in the said complaint, he was called and he was not subjected to any harassment.

4. If the complaint discloses any cognizable offence, the second respondent has to register a case. In case, the said complaint does not disclose any cognizable offence, the second respondent can conduct preliminary enquiry with the complainant and if the said enquiry reveals any cognizable offence, he can register a case and proceed further in accordance with law. Instead of that he should not unnecessarily harass the petitioner.

5. With the aforesaid directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
