Four Demand Drafts for a total value of Rs.6,50,000/- towards the balance amount, have been handed over to the petitioner by the learned counsel for the respondent today.

2.The joint memorandum of compromise is recorded and the same shall form part of the order. The Criminal Revision Case is disposed of in terms of the joint memorandum of compromise. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
