3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner is entitled to all his emoluments which may be admissible as per Rules.

Having perused the Official Memorandum dated 13.02.2020, nothing survives to be adjudicated in this writ petition except directing the respondents to ensure all the payments that are admissible to the petitioner in accordance with law, preferably, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands closed with the above said direction. No costs, Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
