PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.291 of 2019 on the file of
the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the
respondent.

2.The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147,
341 of I.P.C. r/w Section 3(1), 5 of TN Public Property (Prevention
of Damages and Loss) Act 1992, in Crime No.291 of 2019 on the file
of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3.A public transport bus was damaged. The petitioners' counsel
undertakes to take a demand draft favouring the General Manager,
Tamil Nadu Transport Corporation Region, Virudhunagar for a sum of

Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) and enclose the same along with the surrender petition.

4. The Court below shall hand over the original demand draft through the respondent police to the Corporation Officials concerned. This will be a non refundable payment and this will be without prejudice to the petitioners' defence in the trial.

5. Subject to this conditions, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukkottai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
