PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.2 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 417, 376 and 109 of I.P.C., in Crime No. 2 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. On carefully going through the contents of the FIR, it is seen that allegations are only against the son of the petitioners herein namely Ajith Kumar.



4. The petitioner's counsel states that the petitioners will prevail upon their son to surrender before the respondent within a few days.

5. This undertaking is recorded. Since the first accused appears to be the main culprit, I am inclined to grant relief to the petitioners herein. Hence, anticipatory bail is granted.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
