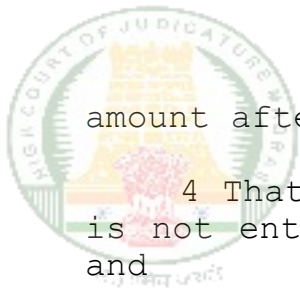
DECREE:-

1 That the award dated 23.07.2004 made in M.C.O.P.No.1120 of 1996 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Additional District and Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court No.I), Madurai be and hereby is confirmed and the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is dismissed.

2 That the Appellant herein / Oriental Insurance Company Limited be and hereby is directed to deposit the respective award amount along with interest at the rate of 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit, with cost within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy this judgment, if not already deposited;

3 That on such deposit being made, the claimant / first respondent be and hereby is permitted to withdraw the award



amount after deducting amount, if any already received by her

4 That the claimant/ first respondent herein be and are hereby is not entitled to interest for the default period if there is any and

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5 That there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
