ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 02.11.2019, for the offences under Section 392 of I.P.C., in Crime No.445 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police. Hence, he seeks bail.

3. It is a case of chain snatching. The petitioner was identified in the test identification parade. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) states that the chain was also recovered based on the confession of the petitioner. She would also



point out that there are other cases registered against the petitioner and they are of the same nature. Hence, I am not inclined to grant any relief and the criminal original petition stands dismissed.
