The wife of the detenu has filed the habeas corpus petition seeking to quash the proceedings of the second respondent in Detention Order in M.H.S.Confdl No.101/2019 dated 20.12.2019, branding the detenu namely, Umesh, Son of Chellappa, aged about 29 years, as a "GOONDA" as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 1982, detained him at the Central Prison, Palayamkottai and to set him at liberty.
