PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 244/2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.244 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor states that the victim was in hospital for about seven days. The petitioner's counsel on instructions gives an undertaking that the petitioner will pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- towards medical expenditure of the defacto complainant. The petitioner will take demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,000/- and enclose the same along with the surrender petition. The said demand draft will be directly handed over to the victim by the Court below through the respondent. This is without prejudice to the petitioner's defence in the criminal trial.



4. Recording the said undertaking I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Illupur, Pudukkottai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
