PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 8/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 307 and 506(ii) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamilnadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.8 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3. As rightly pointed out by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and the learned counsel appearing for the intervener, the second petitioner/Gandhi is said to have inflicted the head injury with an aruval. Therefore, I am not inclined to grant relief to the second petitioner and the criminal original petition is dismissed as far as the second petitioner is concerned.

4. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 1 and 3 to 7 with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 1 and 3 to 7 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 1 and 3 to 7 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners 1 and 3 to 7 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
