PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.266 of 2019 on the file of
the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Additional Public Prosecutor Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing
for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 324 and
307 of I.P.C., in Crime No.266 of 2019, on the file of the
respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The primary allegations are only against the first
petitioner. He is said to have caused the cut injury. Hence, this
criminal original petition is dismissed as regards the first
petitioner is concerned.



4. The allegations made against the petitioners 2 and 3 are not that serious. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 2 and 3 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners 2 and 3 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Illupur, Pudukkottai District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 2 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 2 and 3 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners 2 and 3 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
