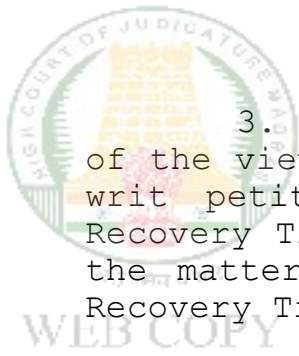

4. In these circumstances, we are not inclined to entertain this writ petition and the same is dismissed. No costs.
