PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.1/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 506(i), 498(A), 494 and 109 of I.P.C., in Crime No.01 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioners are in-laws of the defacto complainant.

4.The petitioner's counsel would point out that the first accused /the husband of the defacto complainant was already arrested. The petitioners will ensure that a sum of Rs.3,000/- is



remitted in the bank account of the defacto complainant. This is, of-course, without prejudice to the right of the defacto complainant to claim higher relief before the jurisdictional Magistrate in appropriate proceedings.

5. Recording the petitioner's undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Keeranur, Pudukkottai District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
