This petition has been filed for relaxing the condition already imposed by this Court, vide orders dated 09.08.2019 and 30.10.2019.

2.Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per the conditions imposed by this Court vide order dated 30.10.2019, the petitioner is complying with the condition by appearing before the All Women Police Station, every day at evening 5.30 p.m. Therefore, if the condition is further relaxed, no prejudice would be caused to anyone and the appellant accused would be able to carry on his daily routine and livelihood also.

4.In view of the said submission, the condition already imposed by this Court is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall report before the Mahila Court, (Fast Track Mahila Court), Theni, on the first working day of every month till the disposal of the criminal appeal.
