PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

for Bail in Crime No.499 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is arrayed as accused No.2. He was arrested and remanded to Judicial Custody on 16.09.2019 for the offence punishable under section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.499 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

3. The petitioner is said to be a habitual recipient of stolen properties. That is why, the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) opposes the bail petition.

4. In as much as the investigation in this case is concluded and the petitioner is only the recipient of the stolen

properties, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

(i) the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for the interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
