PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

**PRAYER :-**

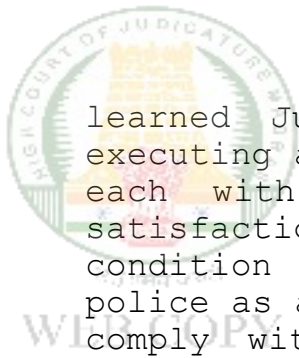
For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.223 of 2019 on the file of the respondent.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.223 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. Even in the FIR it is mentioned that the sand was sourced only from the private patta land. It is not the case of the prosecution that the land owner had given any complaint. The petitioners are not having any previous case. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the



learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

4. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
