PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.2 of 2020 on the file of the respondent.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 498A, 494 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.02 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3. The learned counsel for the petitioners states that the defacto complainant, the wife of the first petitioner had eloped with another person. He also would point out that two children born through the wedlock are with the first petitioner. The first petitioner also further undertakes that he will remit a sum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) to the bank account of the defacto complainant. This will be a monthly remittance. The monthly remittance will be made on or before 10th of every month. The first petitioner's liability will be commenced from next month onwards. Ofcourse, this is only an interim arrangement and it will abide by the final order that may be passed by the jurisdictional civil Court or family Court.

4. Recording the undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manaparai, Trichy, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
