PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

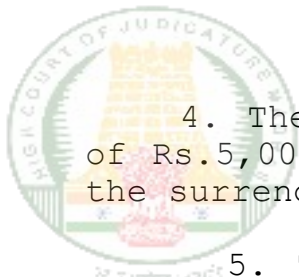
For Anticipatory bail in Crime No.6 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 323, 447, 427, 324, 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.6 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioners are not having any previous case.



4. The petitioners undertake to take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,000/- favouring the victim and enclose the same along with the surrender petition.

5. The same will be handed over by the Court below to the victim through the respondent police. Of-course, this will be without prejudice to the petitioner's defence in the trial. The arrest of the petitioners is not going to serve any purpose.

6. Recording the undertaking, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of seven days. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
