for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.4 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police

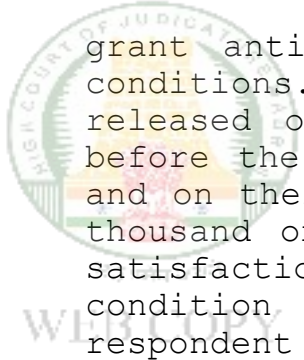
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, the
learned counsel appearing for the intervener and the learned
Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 498(A), 294(b),
323, 406 and 506(i) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamilnadu Prohibition
of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.4 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The allegations made against the first petitioner are
rather serious. The first petitioner is said to have assaulted the
defacto complainant. The defacto complainant through her counsel
would allege that the first petitioner is virtually job less.
Hence, this criminal original petition is dismissed as regards the
first petitioner is concerned.

4. The other petitioners are only in-laws. There are no
serious allegations against the in-laws. Hence, I am inclined to



grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 2 to 4 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners 2 to 4 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Andipatti, Theni District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 2 to 4 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 2 to 4 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners 2 to 4 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
