Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the petition filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to suspend the sentence passed by the learned I Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR) Trichirappalli in S.C.No.53 of 2017, dated 07/09/2019 and enlarge the petitioner on bail pending disposal of the above Crl.A. and thus render justice.

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.J.SANJEY VIGNESH, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.V.NEELAKANDAN, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been convicted by the learned trial judge, for the alleged offence under Section 147 of IPC, and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/-, in default to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two months and for the alleged offence under Section 304(ii) r/w 149 of IPC and sentenced him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of eight years and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- in default to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of twelve months and for the alleged offence under Section 323 r/w 149 of IPC and to pay a fine of Rs.7,50/- in default to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one month in S.C.No.53 of 2017 on the file of the I Additional District and Sessions Court (PCR), Trichirappalli.

2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there are several infirmities in the prosecution case and further there are contradictions in material particulars between the
