PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

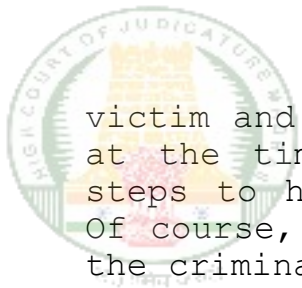
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.298 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.298 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioners' counsel on instructions gives an undertaking that the first petitioner will give a hand written letter of apology addressed to the defacto complainant expressing their regret for their action. He gives a further undertaking that the first petitioner will take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,000/- towards meeting the medical expenditure incurred by the



victim and the same will be enclosed along the petition to be filed at the time furnishing the sureties. The court below shall take steps to hand over the same to the victim through the respondent. Of course, this is without prejudice to the petitioners' defence in the criminal trail.

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4. Recording these undertakings, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi, Ramanathapuram District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
