PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.21 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and
the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the
respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 427,
448, 506(i) and 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No. 21 of 2020 on the file
of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant is the landlord of the petitioners
herein. The learned counsel for the petitioners would point out
that the landlord Mutt has filed O.S.No.428 f 2012 on the file of
the respondent police, against the first petitioner herein. The



said suit was dismissed on merits. The petitioners on the other hand filed O.S.No.722 of 2012 seeking the relief of injunction and the same was decreed. The learned counsel for the petitioners would alleges that these adverse developments in a civil suit had impelled the landlord to give this complaint thorough the Mutt Manager.

4.I find force in the said contention of the petitioner. In any event, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Madurai, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
