PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory bail in Crime No289. of 2019 on the file of the respondent police

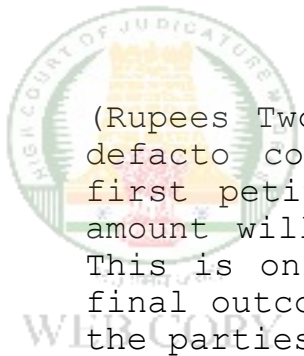
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 323, 506(ii), 498(A) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act in Crime No.289 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions states that the first petitioner will deposit a sum of Rs.2,500/-

(Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) in the bank account of the defacto complainant as monthly maintenance. The liability of the first petitioner will commence from the next month onwards. The amount will have to be deposited on or before 10th of every month. This is only an interim arrangement and this would be abide by the final outcome of the proceedings that may be instituted by either of the parties.

4. Subject to these conditions, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sayalgudi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
