PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.34 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under section 420 of I.P.C., in Crime No.34 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner is figuring as A2. According to the petitioner, it is only A1 who is responsible for causing loss to the defacto complainant. The petitioner's counsel states that the loss caused to the defacto complainant has been made good. It is stated



that on 23.12.2019 a sum of Rs.18,082/- was remitted by A1 to the defacto complainant. Again on 25.12.2019 a sum of Rs.13,000/- was remitted by A1.

4. I am of the view that considering the nature of allegations, arrest of the petitioner is not going to serve any purpose. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Madurai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
