for Anticipatory bail in Crime No.15 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

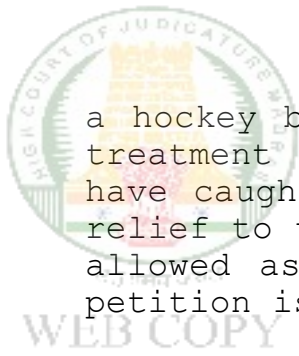
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 342, 323, 506(2) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of TNPHW, in Crime No.15 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. It is seen that the first petitioner had hit the victim with

a hockey bat causing him head injury. The victim is still taking treatment in the Hospital. The second petitioner is only said to have caught hold of the victim. Therefore, I am inclined to grant relief to the second petitioner. This criminal original petition is allowed as regards the second petitioner. This criminal original petition is dismissed as regards the first petitioner.

4. Accordingly, the second petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Alangulam, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The second petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The second petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
