PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory bail in Crime No.44 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

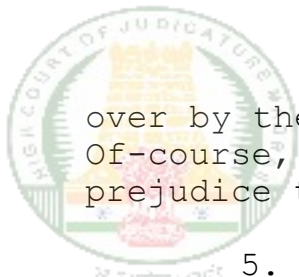
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 324 and 506(2) of I.P.C., in Crime No.44 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner's father has been arrested and remanded to custody. The petitioner is said to have assaulted the defacto complainant resulting in his hospitalization for a period of four days.

4. This Court directs the petitioner to take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.2,000/- favouring the victim and enclose the same along with the surrender petition, so that, the same can be handed



over by the Court below to the victim through the respondent police. Of-course, the compliance of this direction will not in any way prejudice the petitioner's defence in the trial.

5. Subject to the said condition, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Vadipatti, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
