PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.20 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and
the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the
respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 147, 148, 294(b),
323, 324, 506(ii) and 307 of I.P.C., in Crime No.20 of 2020 on the
file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3. Serious allegations have been made against the petitioners 1, 2 and 4. They have caused cut injuries on the defacto complainant as well as on the father of the defacto complainant.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the victims are still taking treatment in the hospital and the condition of the father of the defacto complainant is rather critical. The petitioners 1 and 2 are having previous cases. Taking note of the serious allegations made against them, this criminal original petition stands dismissed as regards the petitioners 1, 2 and 4.

5. However, taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners 3, 5 and 6 with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners 3, 5 and 6 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 3, 5 and 6 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 3, 5 and 6 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners 3, 5 and 6 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
