PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.31 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 323, 506(2) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002, in Crime No.31 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant is none other than the mother of the petitioner. The petitioner's mother is said to be suffering from terminal illness (cancer). The petitioner is said to have refused to vacate the house in question. But the house in question is standing in the name of the petitioner's father. Therefore, the petitioner obviously has a share in the property. But then, the petitioner is statutorily obliged to maintain his mother.
