PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory bail in Crime No.22 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 147, 148, 294(b),
324 and 452 of I.P.C., in Crime No.22 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant has alleged that his brother
was attacked on his left hand and that he suffered



fracture.

4. The petitioners' counsel on instructions states that the petitioners undertake to take a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,000/- favouring the said Rajkamal and enclose the along with their surrender petition. The court below shall hand over the original demand draft to the said Rajkamal through the respondent police. This will be the non refundable payment and it is without prejudice to the petitioners' defence in the trial.

5. Subject to this condition, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
