PRAYER :-

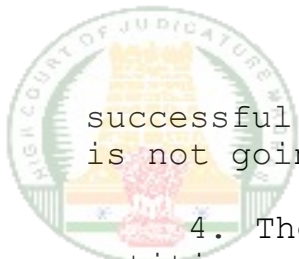
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 1 of 2020 on the file of
the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 7, 7(A)
of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended in 2018, in Crime
No. 1 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks
anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner has since been suspended from service by
order dated 29.01.2020. In view of the suspension, the petitioner
seeks to continue the investigation. The trap was laid and it was



successful against the second accused. The arrest of the petitioner is not going to serve any purpose.

4. Therefore, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Theni, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
