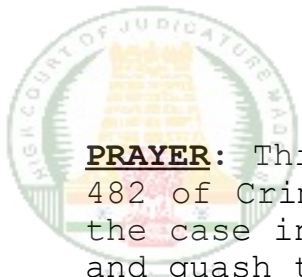

COMMON ORDER

These Criminal Original Petitions have been filed to quash the FIR in Crime Nos.14 of 2020 for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324, 506(2) of IPC and in Crime No.15 of 2020 for the offences under Sections 294(b), 324 & 506(ii) of IPC on the file of the first respondent police as against the petitioners.

2. The cases are still at the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. The Joint Memo of Compromise have been filed before this Court, which have been signed by the petitioners and the private respondents and also by their respective counsel. The petitioners and the private respondents were also present in person before this Court and they were identified by M/s. R. Jothilakshmi, HC-1412, Mayanur P.S. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the First Information Reports pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Guj Rath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the First Information Report in Crime Nos. 133 & 134 of 2019.

5. It is represented by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have paid a sum of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) as costs to the Credit of the M.S. Chellamuthu Trust and Research Foundation and filed the original cash receipts along with this memo on 03.02.2020. The said submission is placed on record.

6. Accordingly, these Criminal Original Petitions are allowed
