PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.02 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 324 and
506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.2 of 2020 on the file of the
respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The defacto complainant's son was badly injured. It is
stated that the petitioner's family had given a sum of Rs.5,00,000/-
towards cost of medical treatment. The victim's mother who is
defacto complainant is present in person before me. She confirmed
that the petitioner's family bore the cost of medical treatment to
the extent of Rs.5,00,000/-.

4. Inasmuch as the petitioner's family has shown their bonafidies, I am of the view that the arrest of the petitioner is not necessary. Hence, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Eraniel, Kanyakumari District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
