PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in S.C. No.121/2011 on the file of the District Sessions Judge, Sivagangai.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 427 of I.P.C., and 3(ii)(a) of TNPPDL Act, 1984, in S.C.No.121 of 2011 before the District Sessions Judge, Sivagangai and in Crime No.198 of 2008 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The petitioner through his counsel gives an undertaking that he will appear in all the future hearings without any default. If he is unable to appear, his counsel will represent him and file



an application under Section 317 of Cr.P.C. On account of the petitioner's absence, trial will not be stalled. If this undertaking is breached, the order now passed will stand vacated automatically and the petitioner will be remanded to custody.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions states that the petitioner comes forward to remit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) to the District legal Authority, Sivagangai.

5. Recording the said undertaking given by the petitioner through his counsel, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Court below on the hearing date and apply for recall of warrant. On such application is being filed, the Court below shall recall the warrant at the end of the day. Non Bailable Warrant shall be kept in abeyance till then.

6. The Criminal Original petition stands disposed of, on these terms.
