PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

**PRAYER :-**

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 22/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324, 307 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.22 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. The occurrence had taken place in the background of the recently concluded local body elections. The complainant's daughter-in-law succeeded and that is said to be the motive for the occurrence.



4.The first and third petitioners are having several previous cases, out of them, some are under Section 307 of IPC. No serious allegations have been made against the petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6.

5.Therefore, even while dismissing this petition for petitioners 1 and 3, anticipatory bail is granted as regards the petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6 are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi, Ramanathapuram District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6 shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

7. The petitioners 2, 4, 5 and 6 shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
